

# ACEM 2022 conference "The Motorcycle Industry's Vision for decarbonisation"

A high-level panel of industry and technology experts will discuss the the motorcycle industry's latest initiatives in the area of decarbonisation, within the context of the EU's climate targets and the industry's Vision 2030+.
